



REPORT FROM THE COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE

The COMPS Committee met on Friday 13th October at the University of Abertay - immediately following the AU Forum. The group enjoyed a very positive and productive meeting.

The following points represent the primary items of business:

- **SDC Appointments & Budgets** – SF has been charged with finalising appointments and confirming sports budgets with the SDCs. Funding will be distributed against agreed headings and will allow for new events and improved programmes to be delivered
- **Events list** – The committee welcomed the creation of a pan-SUS sports event list for the season. The list is growing day by day as more dates and locations are finalised but is already well in excess of 50 for the season. - **COMPS Action Plan** - A re-formatted version of the action plan was approved at the meeting and progress was noted on several key areas including SUS Kit, medals and insurance.
- **SDC Forum & SGB Seminar** – Following advice from Neil Park at the SSA, it has been agreed to deliver two distinct events over the coming month. The first will be an internal gathering of the SDC Forum (title – A Question of SUS) and this will be followed by a workshop seminar including SGB reps.
- **Representative Multi-Sport Event** – The group underlined a wish to advance plans for an alternative to BUGS. Edinburgh and Heriot-Watt universities have since offered to host an event in early April. Details of the sports and opponents to be included in this event are to be confirmed over the coming month or so.
- **Celebrating Sporting Success** – The group opened discussions on developing ways of celebrating the success of SUS players, coaches and volunteers. Ideas included creation of an annual awards dinner and a SUS Hall of Fame. Further discussion will form part of future meetings.
