

<b>REPORT FROM THE COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE</b>

The SUS Competitions Committee met last on the 13<sup>th</sup> March at SUS HQ.

An update of activities/ developments since the last Exec meeting is included below:

- Five major recommendations for the future of league based sports are currently being considered – this was the follow on from student consultation conducted in December 07
- ‘BUGS’ was successfully delivered in Edinburgh earlier this month, with strong inputs from across the SUS network. The organisation of the event has been praised by athletes and by colleagues from BUSA. Scotland finished in second place behind England (gap of 6 points) with Wales and NI sharing third place
- A number of SDC vacancies have been filled, including Equestrian and Cricket, with interim arrangements in place for Tennis
- The fixture planning process for 2008-09 is now underway – being ably led by Ross Campbell with support from SF
- The 2008 SUS Awards application process is now live. Members are asked to note the nomination deadline of May 16<sup>th</sup> and to ensure that nominations are double-signed (where appropriate) by key stakeholders at each institution
