

REPORT FROM THE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COMMITTEE

SUSPAC had its last meeting on Thursday 3rd April at Abertay University and this included a workshop in the afternoon looking at issues around careers in sport.

The meeting updated on a number of issues and the following points represent the primary items of business:

- **Careers Workshop** - Key members from across the network joined us for the afternoon session. The topic for discussion was "Careers - how can we cater for our students through what they learn and experience at university, and how can we prepare them for their future?" There are a growing number of sports-related degrees out there but it can be very difficult to turn that into a career. The group focused on what else we need to give students and what else they need to get for themselves. The session highlighted a number of areas for future investigation and a note of the meeting will be available soon to download from the SUS website.
