

Right to Play

You will hopefully be aware of the partnership between BUCS and the Charity Right to Play. Before Christmas a representative from Right to Play contacted the SUS office to ask about being able to create a partnership specific with SUS in addition to the one already in existence with BUCS.

The proposed partnership would see a level of joint promotion with SUS also helping Right to Play in a recruitment drive to secure Student Ambassadors in Scottish Universities and Colleges.

Right to Play have asked if SUS would pledge to raise a certain amount of money annually for the charity and this would be in addition to encouraging individual institutions within the network to do the same.

This agreement would see Right to Play become the official SUS charity but would not preclude us from being able to raise funds for other organisations where appropriate.

PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT – Right to Play

This document briefly outlines the main rights and responsibilities of both Right to Play as a partner and SUS as an organisation. Please note that this is a voluntary partnership agreement only and does not constitute a contract of employment.

The following has been agreed between Scottish Universities Sport and Right to Play and is designed to be reviewed on an annual basis.

SUS agrees to:

- Provide Right to Play with stories and other content for their website.
- Promote Right to Play website to SUS members through the placement of a link on the SUS partners page on the website and announcement through SUS news.
- Encourage SUS members to use www.students4righttoplay.org.uk forums and share information.
- Provide Right to Play with a comprehensive list of relevant contact details for the year.
- Allow Right to Play to have a presence at SUS events, where appropriate, to report on activity and promote themselves.
- Include Right to Play in regular sector updates about SUS activities and events.
- Provide Right to Play with relevant SUS brand artwork and guidelines for use.
- Assist Right to Play in a recruitment drive to secure Student Ambassadors in Scottish Universities and Colleges.
- Agree to raise a set amount of funds **HOW MUCH??** for Right To Play over the course of the year from SUS and encourage Scottish Universities to host events and activities to raise further funds for them.

Right to Play agrees to:

- Allow SUS to use stories from the Right to Play website on their own site, where appropriate.
- Provide www.students4righttoplay.org.uk site which will house University specific news and links.
- Allow SUS groups to use the Forums on this site for discussions.
- Keep SUS up-to-date with volunteering and coaching opportunities that Scottish students can be involved in.
- Keep in regular communication with the SUS Office and other relevant parties as appropriate.
- Promote Scottish Universities Sport wherever possible through the Right to Play website.
- Provide SUS with relevant Right to Play brand artwork and guidelines for use.
