

<b>REPORT FROM THE COMPS COMMITTEE</b>

The Comps Committee met on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September and Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2010 at Stirling and Glasgow respectively. Four sub-groups have also met in between times to progress work in their designated priority areas.

Key Points

**Operational Plan**

Work is progressing well against the ten action areas in the plan. Items 1- 4 are managed by the sub-groups, with the other items being addressed through the Sports Manager's work plan.

**Officiating Project - 'Reffing Brilliant'**

The official launch weekend for this programme, to take place at St Andrews Uni (28-30 Jan) is taking shape. The 80 or so officials on the programme will each follow a deployment plan for 12 months following the launch, during which time they will be actively engaged and supported by SUS and the relevant SGB.

**Coaching**

CC & SF met with the 9 new Regional Coaching and Volunteering Managers who have just started employment with **sportscotland** during their first week (late OCT). It is hoped that this will pave the way for local partnership work in coaching, volunteering and officiating projects. SUS will also be represented at the launch of the new Coaching Scotland framework on 18<sup>th</sup> Nov

**Fixtures and events**

The Events planner is now in place and this has been well received by both the members and the SDC's. Any hiccups have been minor and will be easily remedied for future seasons. Online entries to SUS events will be live pre-Christmas, with standardised systems for feedback also being implemented in the New Year.

**Cup Finals**

Planning is underway for the Conference Cup Finals 2011, to be staged at Dundee University on March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

In addition to these project areas, the primary focus for Comps over the coming months will be to deliver high-quality Rep sport programmes in selected sports and develop further SUS' relationship with selected governing bodies.
