

<b>REPORT FROM THE COMPS COMMITTEE</b>

The Comps Committee met on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2011. The key update points are as follows:

**Operational Plan**

Work is progressing well against the ten action areas in the plan. Items 1- 4 are managed by the sub-groups, with the other items being addressed through the Sports Manager's work plan.

**Officiating Project - 'Reffing Brilliant'**

The launch event went ahead at end Jan despite the disappointingly low final numbers. 20 officials across 3 sports (Basketball, netball & Rugby) completed the introductory tuition and benefited from the sports psychology presentation from Dr Alan Macpherson. Candidates will now be supported through the coming months as they complete their qualifications and begin officiating in student and community fixtures. Discussions have begun about re-scheduling elements of the event for later in the year.

**Fixtures and Events**

A list has been sent out with all the fixtures that need re scheduling so hopefully this will spur people into action. All events and bookings more or less go through SUS now and there can be charges depending on event. RS to liaise with JS to work on in kind costs. MH is reviewing the current process for gathering feedback from events. RS to get seasons guidelines for 11/12 season.

**Coaching**

CC is responsible for compiling a contacts sheet that can be sent out to all Universities and Sports Scotland Regional Coaching Coordinators.

**Cup Finals**

Two meetings have taken place at University of Dundee to look at the SUS Cup Finals day. The group are tasked with compiling an event organising document that can be used in the future should the event be taken to another venue.

**Policies**

The group will review the current policies over the next few months.

In addition to these project areas, the primary focus for Comps over the coming months will be to deliver high-quality Rep sport programmes in selected sports and develop further SUS' relationship with selected governing bodies. Work has already begun in Football, Rugby, Netball and Basketball.
