

REPORT FROM THE COMPETITONS COMMITTEE

The Comps Committee met on Tuesday 18th January 2011 at Peffermill. The comps review group have also met on a few occasions. The key update points are as follows:

Fixtures and Events

The committee decided this year to have a stricter approach to fixtures to make sure that more matches were played and that there was not a panic to squeeze them all in come the deadline at the end of March. This approach has worked and there has been a much fairer approach to fixtures this year. The amount of matches played is up on last year and there were fewer issues to sort out between universities. There has been some discussion around the administration of fixtures and this will be a focus, as you have seen in the Future working paper.

This has been the first year of events under the SUS Events Calendar and it has been a massive success so far. It has made it much fairer and easier from an admin point of view to run events around the universities. Sportalise has also been used for a couple of events with great success, allowing for admin time to be saved and the event to be run in a far more professional manner.

Massive thanks must go to The University of Dundee for hosting and in particular all the hard work Paul McPate and his team put in to the run up and the running on the actual day. 11 different institutions were represented on the day in 8 sports through 14 finals.
