



Job Description for Competitions Committee – University Student Representative

The Competitions Committee comprises: Chair, 4x departmental staff (1 College, 1 University at least), 1x Sports Development Coordinator, 4x student sports representatives (1 College, 1 University at least) and 1 BUCS representative. It is supported by the SSS Sports Coordinator. Other members can be co-opted on to the committee throughout the year to assist in its work and to learn more about how it operates before seeking nomination at AGM to pursue a formal committee position.

Time commitment and role:

- 6 half-days days per year for committee meetings
- Option to join the Chair at Executive Council meetings which take place 5 times per year (half days)
- Discuss and make decisions on the long term Operational Plan for competition in Scottish Student Sport
- To make sure SSS Competitions Policies are up to date and effective
- Improve the quality of Competition in SSS
- Report back to the AU Forum
- Represent the opinions of students
- Help plan the fixtures for the following year
- Assist the group and Sports Coordinator to Prepare reports for NGBs, BUCS and other related organisations

There is also a certain amount of preparation, reading, and pondering required.

In addition there may be the option for **University Student Representative** committee members to job shadow department staff members to gain an insight into their jobs and to gain experience/skills in new areas.
