

REPORT FROM THE COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE

The SUS Competitions Committee met last on the 5th May at Glasgow

An update of activities/ developments since the last Exec meeting is included below:

- **SUS Competitions Operational Plan** – The SUS Comps Operational plan has again brought focus to the work of the committee, with all primary priority actions having been completed this year. If anyone would like to see the end of year status report then please contact SF
- **College Sport** - SUS continues to have regular dialogue with colleagues from the college sector with a view to working on parallel and/or integrated programmes for 2009-10. Planning of a research project into the current picture of provision in the sector is also underway.
- **Rep' Sport** – A rep sport questionnaire is currently being drafted with the aim to get this out to SDCs, players and former players by the end of May
- **BUGS 2010** – Working group formed. Edinburgh Uni has been asked to approach Pollock Halls regarding accommodation which in turn will provide BUGs 2010 with a steer on dates. It is hoped to have confirmed sports/ dates and budgets in place by end June
- **Blues** – All Institutions were asked to send Paul McPate their Blues Criteria with a potential to see if a National Blues Framework could be unified and sought. This is in early discussion at this moment in time
- **Events Calendar** – The SUS office is currently re-jigging the format to make it more user-friendly for institutions to complete. It is still hoped that the process can be completed in time to inform the 2009-10 season plan
- **SUS Awards** – Nomination forms are now out in the public domain – closing date May 20th
