

<b>REPORT FROM THE COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE</b>

The SUS Competitions Committee met last on the 13<sup>th</sup> October at Strathclyde University.

An update of activities/ developments since the last Exec meeting is included below:

- **SUS Competitions Operational Plan** – An updated plan – based on the strategic commitments in the SUS 5 yr vision – has been created and adopted by the group This plan will form the backbone of all COMPS work over the year ahead.
- **College Sport** – Please see separate update (m22~7)
- **Priority Sports** – The following sports have been selected as priority sports for the coming year: Aquatics, Archery, Basketball, Golf and Tennis. Comps hopes to have similar success in these sports as it has had in the likes of Football, Rugby, Hockey and Cross-Country in terms of structural development, NGB liaison and participation levels.
- **Development Days** – The feedback we have received from the SDC's was that the day itself was really useful for engaging and educating the captains. Concerns were raised on the attendance and whether holding the event at a different period in the year might be better. The group feel that it is the responsibility of the AU's to make sure that each of there clubs are represented at these events.
- **BUGS 2010** – SF and RC hosted the other NTMs on Friday 2nd October. A tour of the facilities was followed by discussions about the sports involved, numbers within each sport and the future of rep sport within the home nations. All NTMs had to confirm whether they would be entering each specific sport by the start of November.
- **Blues** – This remained on our radar from last year and will be picked up again by Phil Gallagher and Paul McPate. It is hoped that the collation of Blues criteria information will help as a reference point for the sector and allow governing bodies to gain a better understanding of the awards.
- **Events Calendar** – Although it's been difficult collecting the information, almost every University has now replied with the relevant data. A small group of RC, SF and RS will then meet and start to process this information. It is hoped that we will have a rough plan of events by the next time that Comps meets.
