

<b>REPORT FROM COMPS</b>

The Comps Committee has met twice since the last executive meeting, firstly at Dundee on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2009 and then at Heriot-Watt University on 26<sup>th</sup> January. Below is a summary of the main 'headlines'

**Conference Cup Update**

With the exception of Rugby, all Conference Cup Finals will take place at Dundee University on Wednesday 24th March. A sub group of comps has been formed to oversee the organisation and running of the event and the Marketing group are on hand to increase publicity of the event.

**BUCS Home Nations 2010**

There has been a change in name to what was formerly known as BUGs. This new title fits in with the new organisations corporate branding. The schedule for the event is now with the other nations for feedback. SUS have appointed James Williamson as National Team Manager and Ross Simpson as his assistant.

**Selected Sports Update**

A handful of sports have been given extra resources this year in order to strengthen the organisational structure and/ or progress with broader development initiatives. These are Archery, Aquatics, Basketball, Golf and Tennis.

**Events Planner**

The events planner will be distributed to SDC's and to University Departments in the next week. After a two week turnaround, all feedback will be digested and final event information confirmed. We hope to have a template for each tournament and sport available online by the first week in August for events for the full academic year 2010/11.

**SDC Name Change**

It was agreed that title of Sports Development Coordinator was getting a little dated and we needed a new title of what the role reflects. It was agreed that the current SDC's would now be called, drum roll... Chair of Scottish Universities (Chosen Sport)

**Fixtures 2010/11**

It was agreed that, despite the current mediation work between SUS and BUCS, SUS Comps should continue its good work in preparing fixtures for the new academic year. A sub group of comps has been set up to collect University data required for this process to work.

**College Sport**

Jenni updated the group on current work going on in the college sector, including strong uptake in events and memberships (25 colleges), completion of the sector-wide sports audit and progress with the consultancy project looking at the future.
