

## REPORT FROM COMPS

The Comps Committee has met once since the last executive meeting, at SUS HQ on 27<sup>th</sup> April. Below is a summary of the main 'headlines'

### Volunteering

Comps are focusing some time on volunteering to look at a possible national award that might suit all its members. At present there is not on award that suits all and with volunteering so important to SUS comps feels that there should be some focus on this.

### Events Debrief

It was agreed that Conference cup finals were a massive success this year and it was agreed to go for the same approach next year of having one institution hosting the event. There will be a formal bidding process to host the event in place for next year. Home Nations was also a great success and feedback has been very positive. The event ran very smoothly thanks to SF and all the volunteers. The College Finals were also a great success for the first event of its kind for Scottish Colleges.

### Coaching Plan

A lot of time has been spent on what can be done in the area of coaching. Comps are currently designing a template to give to unis to help gather coaching information for their benefit. The SUS audit gathers numbers of coaches each year and more focus is being put on coaching strategies with in each sports development group. The importance is to make sure that each University knows who is coaching what, where and to focus on educating unis about best practice involving coaches.

### Performance Sport

A Performance Booklet has now been created and is currently being branded up by Grant at Glasgow. The Booklet will be ready for conference for everyone to see.

### Events Admin

The plan is to table the events planner at the director's forum to ask for an official line on it from all the members. The way event entries are entered and paid for are being looked at to have a more professional method, such as doing them all online. Survey Monkey is being purchased so that more can be done to gather event feedback to help always improve events.

### Fixtures 2010/11

A sub committee are meeting mid May to sort out all the Scottish leagues after Play offs are completed. The first draft of fixtures will be done by mid June and the final Fixtures will go live by 1<sup>st</sup> August.

### Fixture guidance

More focus is being put on getting fixtures played and what methods will best help clubs with the admin of fixtures.
