1. Eligibility: Shall be as defined by the rules of the Scottish Universities Sports
2. Venue: Shall be mutually agreed.
3. Date: The date shall be decided after the publication of the Scottish Rowing regatta programme.

NOTES

- (A) Further categories may be added by mutual agreement.
- (B) Oarsmen/women may not enter for more than one eights event.
- (C) Oarsmen/women may not enter for more than one coxed fours event.
- (D) A sculler may not enter for more than one single sculls event.
- (E) A university entering one or more (non-novice) eights shall enter the better crew in category 1 (male), 15 (female) and the other in category 2 (male), 16 (female) unless eligible under (F).
- (F) A university entering one (non-novice) eight may enter it in category 2 (male), 16 (female) if it is Restricted 2 status or below.
- (G) Categories 1, 2, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11,12, 13, 15, 16,18, 22, 23, 24 25, 26 and 27 are open to any crew/sculler.
- (H) Categories 3, 7, 17 and 21 are only open to competitors who have joined the club and learned to row/scull in the current academic year.

- (I) Categories 5 and 19 are only open to crews of Restricted 1 status or below.
- (J) Categories 6, 14, 20 and 28 are only open to any crew/sculler of Restricted 2 status or below.
- (K) A university may only enter one crew or sculler in 1, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 18, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27
- (L) A university may enter 2 crews in 2nd eights and 2nd fours if they have a crew in equivalent championship event
- (M) There are no limits on entries for all other events
- (N) All categories will be over 2000m, bar 3, 7, 17 and 21 which will be over 1000m

5. Status: All events shall be non-status promoting.

6. Entry: All eligible, as defined by Scottish Universities Sports (SUS), Scottish University Boat/Rowing Clubs shall be invited to participate in the Championships.

7. Rules: The Scottish Rowing Rules of Racing shall apply, where appropriate, to the Championships, but at all times SUS requirements will apply. **All competitors shall have a Scottish Rowing racing licence.**

8. Prizes: Medals shall be awarded as follows: 2-5 entries gold
6-8 entries gold and silver
over 8 entries gold, silver and bronze.
