For organisation matters events 184, 186 191, 283, 288 and 292 may be combined with the equivalent SPR event. This could result in it being a qualifying race but winners, if a university, would be awarded both prizes. If not the winner, the first placed university would be awarded the university champions medal.

Entries **MUST** be made on-line from the link for Strathclyde Park Regatta on www.scottish-rowing.org.uk and entry fees should be sent to the entries secretary for the Strathclyde Park Regatta (address below). Double entries will be accommodated any more are **at your own risk. No competitor may enter more than 4 races on the same day.**

The entry fee for the Scottish Universities Championship is **£8.50** per head. A reduced entry of **£6.00** per head is payable for the Strathclyde Park Regatta if competing in a university event (see S.P.R. entry form for more details), only one reduced entry per competitor for each university event entered. That is, for example, if you have ten members competing in the university Championships you can have ten reduced entries in the SPR event - they do not have to be the same members. Cheques should be made payable to **Scottish Rowing.**

Closing date for entries 5pm Tuesday 12th April 2011

Draw will be held at Strathclyde Park on Saturday 16th April 2011.

If not paying online, payment should be sent to: **SPR Entries Secretary, National Rowing Academy, Strathclyde Country Park, Motherwell, ML1 3ED**, by Thursday 14th April 2011.

NOTE. A competitor may compete for his/her university in the Championships and for an open club in the Strathclyde Park Regatta (but not both an open club and university club in the open regatta).
